Zeeland offers unique advantages for the production of insect-based proteins



A diverse agricultural sector providing a range of different types of biomass to meet your substrate needs

- Zeeland is the largest agricultural province in the Netherlands with approximately 2800 farms growing cereals, potatoes, grain legumes, sugar beets, wheat grain, and flax.
- Cargill operates a wheat and corn processing facility in Zeeland and is open to partnering with insect-based protein companies.
- Other major producers of agri-food products, such as potatoes and sugar beets, have side-stream valorization initiatives and are also interested in new partnerships.
- Major categories of biomass include potato steam peels, sugar beet leaves, wheat straw (wet and dry), onion leaves, and grass seed hay.

Direct access to potential customers for insect-based feed

- Zeeland is home to one of Europe's most established and successful aquaculture industries, which includes both saline and land-based aquaculture.
- The Dutch poultry industry is the largest in Europe and Zeeland is also home to a large concentration of poultry farms.
- Although the total number of pig farms has declined, the Netherlands remains the fifth largest producer of pigs in Europe. Zeeland provides access to concentrations of pig farms in neighboring provinces.
- Sustainability and the use of alternative feeds is high on the agenda of livestock companies in the Netherlands.
